PURPOSE

The purpose of this privacy policy (this "Privacy Policy") is to inform users of our Site of the following:

1. The personal data we will collect;
2. Use of collected data;
3. Who has access to the data collected; and,
4. The rights of Site users.

This Privacy Policy applies in addition to the Terms of Use of our Site.

GDPR

We adhere to the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, known as the General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR"). F

We have not appointed a Data Protection Officer as we do not fall within the categories of controllers and processors required to appoint a Data Protection Officer under Article 37 of the GDPR.

CONSENT

By using our Site users agree that they consent to the conditions set out in this Privacy Policy.

When the legal basis for us processing your personal data is that you have provided your consent to that processing, you may withdraw your consent at any time. If you withdraw your consent, it will not make processing we completed before you withdrew your consent unlawful.

You can withdraw your consent by contacting the Data Controller via the contact details above.

LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

We collect and process personal data about users only when we have a legal basis for doing so under Article 6 of the GDPR.

We rely on the following legal basis to collect and process the personal data of users:

1. Users have provided their consent to the processing of their data for the specific purpose of processing donations.

PERSONAL DATA WE COLLECT

We only collect data that helps us achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.

DATA COLLECTED IN A NON-AUTOMATIC WAY

We may also collect the following data when you perform certain functions on our Site:

1. First and last name;
2. Email address; and
3. Payment information.

This data may be collected using the following methods:

1. Online donation form.

HOW WE USE PERSONAL DATA

Data collected on our Site will only be used for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy or indicated on the relevant pages of our Site. We will not use your data beyond what we disclose in this Privacy Policy.

The data we collect when the user performs certain functions may be used for the following purposes:

1. Payment processing of donations.

WHO WE SHARE PERSONAL DATA WITH

We may disclose user data to any member of our organization who reasonably needs access to user data to achieve the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy.

OTHER DISCLOSURES

We will not sell or share your data with other third parties, except in the following cases:

1. If the law requires it;
2. If it is required for any legal proceeding;
3. To prove or protect our legal rights.

If you follow hyperlinks from our Site to another Site, please note that we are not responsible for and have no control over their privacy policies and practices.

HOW LONG WE STORE PERSONAL DATA

User data will be stored until the purpose the data was collected for has been achieved. You will be notified if your data is kept for longer than this period.

HOW WE PROTECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA

In order to protect your security, we use the strongest available browser encryption and store all of our data on servers in secure facilities. All data is only accessible to our employees. Our employees are bound by strict confidentiality agreements and a breach of this agreement would result in the employee's termination. We also use Stripe.com's secure payment processing for all donations.

While we take all reasonable precautions to ensure that user data is secure and that users are protected, there always remains the risk of harm. The Internet as a whole can be insecure at times and therefore we are unable to guarantee the security of user data beyond what is reasonably practical.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A USER

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights:

1. Right to be informed;
2. Right of access;
3. Right to rectification;
4. Right to erasure;
5. Right to restrict processing;
6. Right to data portability; and
7. Right to object.

CHILDREN

We do not knowingly collect or use personal data from children under 16 years of age. If we learn that we have collected personal data from a child under 16 years of age, the personal data will be deleted as soon as possible. If a child under 16 years of age has provided us with personal data their parent or guardian may contact our privacy officer to have it removed.

HOW TO ACCESS, MODIFY, DELETE, OR CHALLENGE THE DATA COLLECTED
